Section 2: Why we need your personal information

We need your personal information to:

- respond to enquiries,
- to send you news and marketing or promotional information,
- · to manage and run events and activities,
- to manage your work experience or volunteering with us.

Section 3: Legal Information

In order for us to collect and use your information, we have to have a 'legal basis' for doing so. The legal basis for processing your personal information is:

You have given us consent to process your information.

The personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- You have made an enquiry to us
- You subscribed to our e-newsletter
- You have subscribed to our mailing list
- You are attending an event or activity at one of the ELC Museums or run by staff from the ELC Museums
 Service
- Your child or dependent is attending an event or activity at one of the ELC Museums or run by staff from the ELC Museums Service
- You are undertaking a work experience placement with us
- You are applying to volunteer with us or volunteering with us

The kinds of personal information we are collecting include:

- a. Name
- b. Email address
- c. Address
- d. Telephone number
- e. Date of birth
- f. Medical/health information

The type of information listed in point f above is known as 'special category' personal information. We need an additional 'legal basis' in order to process this kind of information. We would only request and record this information in order to safely manage and run an event or activity or to provide you with a safe work experience or volunteering placement.

The legal basis for processing your special category information is:

You have given us explicit consent to process your information.

Section 4: Sharing and transfer

We will not be sharing the information provided with any other ELC department or external organisations.

Your personal information will not be transferred outside of the UK.

Section 5: How long will we keep your personal information?

We keep your personal data in line with our data retention policy, called a Retention Schedule. For a downloadable copy of the Council's Retention Schedule, please visit our website at www.eastlothian.gov.uk and search for 'Retention Schedule'.

Section 6: Your rights

- 1. You have the right to be informed about how your information will be used.
- 2. You have the right to access your personal information. Normally this is done by placing a 'Subject Access Request' with the Council. - 3. You have the right to ask us to correct inaccurate or incomplete information.
- 4. In certain circumstances, you have the right to have your personal information erased.
- 5. In certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to limit the ways we use or share your information.
- 6. In certain circumstances, you have the right to ask us to move, copy or transfer your information to another organisation in an electronic format.
- 7. In certain circumstances, you have the right to object to the ways we process your information.
- 8. In circumstances where your data is processed automatically, without human intervention, you have the right to certain protections.
