#### 1 Low Energy Retrofit in Traditional Town Centres Claire Cockburn

RIAS Conservation Accredited Architect & Passive House Designer Claire Cockburn discusses how to sensitively retrofit our traditional and historic buildings to improve their energy performance whilst preserving their original fabric and character. Claire will share details of a recent low energy retrofit of a traditional building in Dalkeith town centre, and discuss the key elements of a retrofit project, including repair/replacement of traditional windows, replacing a gas boiler with a heat pump and installing internal insulation.

#### 2 Dunbar High Street; A "Real" Place Sarah McLeary

Architect and Urban Designer Sarah McLeary shares her experience of living in Dunbar, and the challenges and rewards in the stewardship of older buildings. Our High Street isn't a fairytale world where you bump into neighbours and friends on every corner, buy delicious local veg and bread, a stone's throw from stunning natural landscapes... or is it? We each have our personal experience of Dunbar High Street; what can we gain by sharing stories?

#### 3 Where does our energy really cost? Richard Eyers

Former oil and gas insider, and greenhouse gas insider, Richard Eyers, talks about the impact of our energy choices on the environment. We have to make informed energy choices. Richard will talk about the impact of our reliance on oil and gas on global heating, why hydrogen isn't necessarily as green as we expect, and tackle some of the phrases used by politicians. Low carbon energy isn't necessarily green, and our increasing reliance on batteries has a significant environmental cost. The best solution? We need to consume less of the Earth's resources and use energy more efficiently.
