The Plan covers the Pencaitland and District Community Council area, which extends from New Winton and Boggs Holdings in the North, Easter and Wester Pencaitland, Wolfstar in the extreme West, South to Glenkinchie, and the farms of Templehall, Peaston Bank, Dodridge, and Peaston in the south. A map of the Community Council area can be seen in the Plan.

The purpose of the Local Place Plan is to help the community, public bodies, landowners, businesses and funders understand how those aspirations and actions will 'land on the ground' and consider how they can each best support positive change in the area.

The Local Place Plan is based on detailed Community Engagement events which were carried out from September 2023 to January 2024, and on a further period of Community Consultation on the Draft Plan in May 2024.
