SUBJECT: Sports Award Scheme - Special Awards

1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To advise on financial assistance to be awarded through the Sports Award Scheme to talented sportsmen and women competing and training outwith the UK and to teams who have competed successfully in national events qualifying them for additional competition either within or outwith the UK.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 It is recommended that an award be made through the Sports Award Scheme as follows :

Rebecca Craig - Dunbar (Karate)	£300
Saltire Team Gymnastics	£500

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 Rebecca competed in the ISHOJ Kumite Cup in Denmark between 24th and 27th January 2014. The competition provided Rebecca with experience at International level and supports selection for future GB representation.
- 3.2 Rebecca also travelled with the Scotland squad to compete in the 41st Junior European Championships between 6th and 10th February.
- 3.3 Saltire Team Gymnastics, based at Meadowmill Sports Centre, has a membership of almost 200 and is now one of the leading gymnastics clubs in Scotland. Three of their teams – Senior National Girls, Junior National Girls and Primary Boys – have qualified to take part in the 2014 British Championships in Stoke on Trent from 23-25 May. As the only three Scottish teams to qualify it is a great achievement for the club but there will be considerable additional expense to the club as a result of

their participation in this event. The total cost of the trip to the club is circa £5,000.
