SUBJECT: Twinning Association Grant Allocation 2018/2019

1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To note East Lothian Twinning Associations' grant allocation for 2018/2019.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 To note the grant allocation.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 As part of the Service's remit for twinning, ongoing assistance is provided to each of East Lothian's Twinning Associations in Dunbar, Haddington, Musselburgh and the Preston Seton Gosford cluster.
- 3.2 Twinning Associations' roles are to establish and maintain friendly relations with their counterparts and through that friendship pursue the promotion of cultural, educational, social, economic, tourist, youth and sporting exchanges, in the interests of the inhabitants of their communities.
- 3.3 Each Twinning Association is asked to provide a breakdown of activities which informs the decision on the amount of funding the association will receive for the forthcoming financial year.
- 3.4 Based on the information provided it is proposed to offer each association a grant of £1,000.

- 3.5 The grant awarded must be reflected within each Association's yearly annual report and accounts and a copy of these must be submitted for council records.
- 3.6 Each Association can still apply for grants under the discretionary grant scheme under exceptional circumstances whereby the one-off grant is exhausted or otherwise committed.
