2. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF 21 SEPTEMBER

The Committee members discussed the fireworks event which had taken place at Musselburgh Racecourse. They agreed that, overall, the event had been very successful but that it would be useful to arrange a meeting with officers to pass on feedback received from constituents and their own thoughts on what had worked well and what might be improved upon in future years.

3a. APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE – ART WALK PROJECTS
