1 PURPOSE

1.1 To inform the Council of contracts awarded (below the Regulated thresholds) during the first quarter of 2023-2024.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The revised East Lothian Council Procurement Procedures were approved by cabinet 17 January 2023.
- 3.2 In line with reporting requirements set out within the procedures, the Procurement Service are to provide quarterly summaries of contracts awarded (below the Regulated thresholds) to the Members Library.
- 3.3 Regulated and Agreement on Government Procurement (GPA) contracts are published separately in the Council's publicly available contract register in accordance with the Procurement Regulations. Details of these contracts can be found on the Council's publicly available contract register published on Public Contracts Scotland. <u>Public Contracts Scotland</u> -<u>Contracts Register</u>
- 3.4 These quarterly reports will also supplement reporting obligations of the Procurement Reform (Scotland) Act 2014, where a Contracting Authority is obliged to prepare and publish an annual report on its regulated procurement activities as soon as reasonably practicable after the end of its financial year. For that reason, the ELC Annual Procurement Report

covering the period from 01 April 2022 to 31 March 2023 will be presented to Cabinet in the autumn of 2023.

- 3.5 During the first quarter of 2023-24 financial year, 12 contracts were awarded below the regulated procurement thresholds with a total value of £1,573,072.66
- 3.6 The table in Appendix A provides details of the contracts awarded (below the Regulated thresholds) during the first quarter of financial year 2023-2024.
