SUBJECT: 2022-23 Awards Made by Common Good Funds

1 PURPOSE

1.1 To notify Elected Members of the various awards made to individuals and groups from the Common Good Funds between April 22 and March 23.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Members are asked to note the report.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 East Lothian Council is responsible for administering Common Good funds for the following four former burghs: Dunbar, Haddington, Musselburgh and North Berwick.
- 3.2 Applications are welcomed from individuals, groups or clubs who can demonstrate a benefit to the people of the area through their activity or positive promotion of the town.
- 3.3 Once applications are received they are considered by the Elected Members who represent those areas in accordance with the Scheme of Administration.
- 3.4 Under the Council's Scheme of Administration it is recommended that the Council is notified of any awards made by the four funds for the towns of Dunbar, Haddington, Musselburgh and North Berwick.
- 3.5 For the financial year 2022-23 the grant awards budget was £199,000 and there have been eight grant awards totalling £82,676, an underspend of £116,324. The eight grant awards are detailed below:
